



## SHEIKHA FATMA BINT MANSOOR BIN ZAYED AL NAHYAN LADIES ENDURANCE CUP

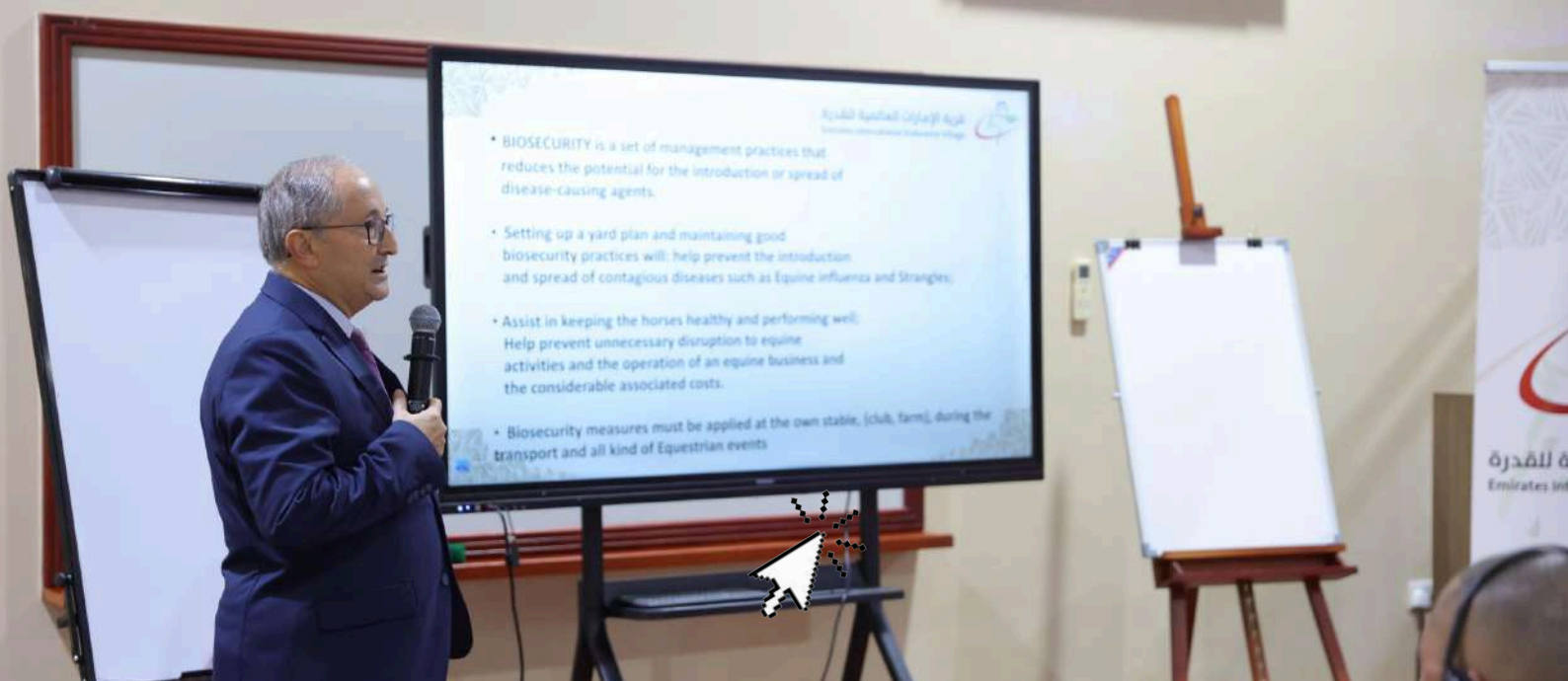
